A note from Artistic Director, Krista Schafer Ewbank

When audience members tell us they laughed until they cried or that our production sparked conversation with their family and friends we know that we have connected with them in an important way. We're so delighted to make theatre that enlightens, challenges, and inspires, and grateful for all the people who help make it happen!

Our 17-18 Season saw us grow in many exciting new ways. Our audience grew by 27%. We hired 30 artists to work on our shows. We were able to work with more designers this year, which greatly increased our production value. We have over 30 volunteers who help with front of house duties, cleaning, set building, website maintenance, and more. The Friends of

Open Book is a new volunteer organization headed by volunteer Toni Mann – and in the past 7 months they refurbished our lobby, sponsored a production, and staffed our tables at two local street fairs.

We continue to get wonderful reviews from our audiences and the critics, and were proud to receive two Wilde Award Nominations this season (Connie Cowper for Best Supporting Actress, and myself for Best Actress).

After 2 years in our beautiful new space we are settling into the rhythm of maintaining the space and managing its use. We'll soon need to be thinking about a new roof for the building, but otherwise the costs of building maintenance should be fairly stable.

We look forward to continued growth. Challenges for the years ahead include being able to raise stipends and salaries for our artists and increasing our organizational staff and volunteers to keep our operations running smoothly. As a scrappy, growing company we have all been working overtime for little to no pay, and as we grow we need to bring our program expenses in line with our operational expenses. We can and should increase our production budgets to continue to raise the bar for our artistic achievement and fairly compensate our artists. This growth is dependent on increased ticket sales and increased giving from individuals, corporate sponsors, and government and foundational grants.

It's exciting to look back on what we've accomplished, and to look forward to all that is to come!


